Important messages

Our PE days will continue to be Mondays and Wednesdays and children need to continue to come to school in their PE uniform. Please remember that the school PE uniform is a plain white T-Shirt, plain blue or black shorts or jogging bottoms, a plain blue or black sports jacket and trainers. Items of clothing should not have large logos and stripes on them and please make sure they have your child's name on them. During our PE lessons we will be going outside so a jacket is important. To help continue to keep all of the children safe, only adults with the correct password will be able to collect from school unless your child has permission to walk home alone.

Within Our Class

Our topic for this term is Predator. We will be learning about the Rainforests, the equator and tropics, and then using all of our learning to create accurate models of the rainforest.

During our writing lessons this term we are going to be focusing on writing to inform. We will be writing a Biography for David Attenborough. David is a very influential person within wildlife and links brilliantly to our Predator topic. We will also be writing a newspaper report all about one of our amazing visits that we have planned this term.

Within Maths this term we will be looking at the properties of 2D and 3D shapes, parallel and perpendicular lines and angles. We will then be focussing on Mass, Capacity and Temperature.

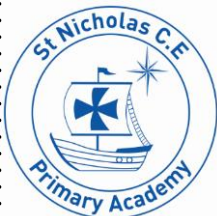
This term our Science topic is Plants. We will be learning about the different parts of a plant, how water travels through plants and the life cycle of flowering plants. We will also be carrying out different scientific experiments to help us to further our knowledge and understanding.

For RE this term we are going to be exploring 'what does it mean to live a good life?' During the term we will be exploring different religions including Hinduism, Christianity and Islam to be able to compare what it means to live a good life. We will be looking at the similarities and differences of what a good life looks like for followers of different religions.
