Welcome back to Summer term 1

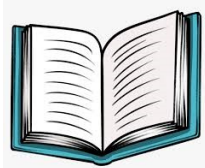

Year 4 expectations

Within Our Class

Our topic this term is "Urban Pioneers". We will begin this topic with our WOW event, where we will be looking at some of Banksy's amazing artwork, before creating some of our own!

During this topic we will have the opportunity to look closely at our town and how it has changed over time. We will look at what major events have happened here, when the first settlers arrived, whether it has been affected by significant disease, such as plague or cholera and the key industries that have helped it to grow

Our **English** lessons this term are going to focus on writing to entertain. This will be through writing narratives in the third person and writing playscripts.

Within **Maths** this term we will continue our unit on decimals where we will be comparing, ordering and rounding. We will then move on to our unit of measure, where we will be able to expand on our knowledge of decimals when looking at money, before moving on to look at time on both analogue and digital clocks.
