Within Our Class

Our **English** lessons this term are going to focus on writing to inform. For this we will be identifying the features of and writing recounts, diary entries and newspaper reports. To do this we will be focussing on writing in chronological order and writing in the past tense.

Within **Maths** this term we will completing our unit of measure, focussing on time, before consolidating our knowledge of the four main operations, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division and using the formal methods to complete number problems.
