

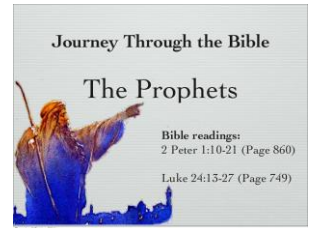

Well isn't time flying by? We are now over half way through this year and entering the second spring term. As we know, last term was challenging for everyone involved in our community. I would like to say a huge thank you to Year 6 and their parents/carers for all the hard work and effort that has already been invested.

Topic – Our topic for this term is centred around exploring the polar regions of the world, some of the hardest and most treacherous places on the entire planet. Year 6 will be finding out about the daring individuals who first tried to conquer these vast expanses, as well as the adaptations animals had to undertake to survive in these harsh environments.

Science - In the Prophets class, our next Science unit that the children will be studying with Mrs Dougill is all about the evolution of animals around the world and how they inherit characteristics which allow them to survive in different environments, including the polar regions. Mrs Dougill will cover how animals have evolved over time by looking at fossils and how animals, such as the Galapagos finches, adapt to where they live and eat.

RE – This term in RE we are 'digging deeper' into the topic – Creation and Science: Conflicting or complimentary? We will be researching and discussing Dr Jennifer Wiseman, a religious scientist, questioning the human race's place in the world, and using Psalm 8 to anchor our discussions in Religious Teaching.
