

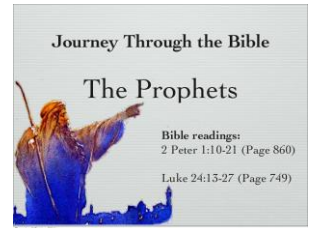

Welcome back Year 6; we hope you have enjoyed your Christmas break as we now look forward to 2021 and what it has in store for all of us at St Nicholas C.E. Primary Academy. As we know, last term was very tricky for everyone but Year 6 did us proud and we are very excited to see how much we can grow and learn over the coming weeks at school.

Topic - This term in our topic lessons, we will be focusing on Science and a very famous British scientist known as Charles Darwin. We will be learning all about his incredible life, journey and how he came to discover one of the most important theories in the history of science.

Science - In the Prophets class, our next Science unit that the children will be studying with Mrs Dougill is all about the classification of animals, plants and micro-organisms. We will uncover how these can all be separated, using very specific criteria, in different groups. The children will be discovering how they can classify living organisms themselves, as well as having lots of opportunities to work scientifically and develop their curiosity.

RE - This term in RE lessons, we will be focusing on two ideas – 'Creation and Science: conflicting or complementary?' We will be comparing the creation story from the Bible in Genesis 1, to Darwin's ideas of evolution in his book 'On the Origin of Species'; asking the question, 'Can a scientist believe in God?'
