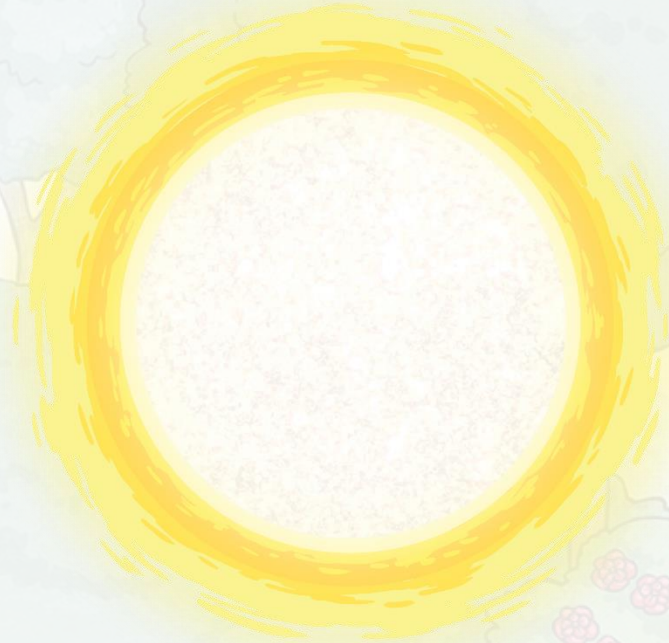


First Day

Third Day

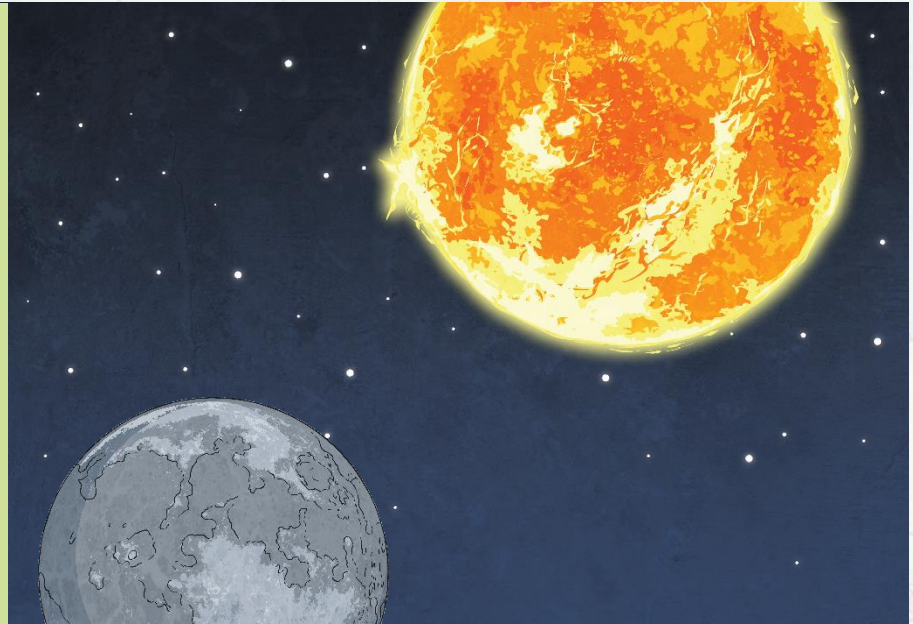
'Let the earth produce plants'.

Fifth Day

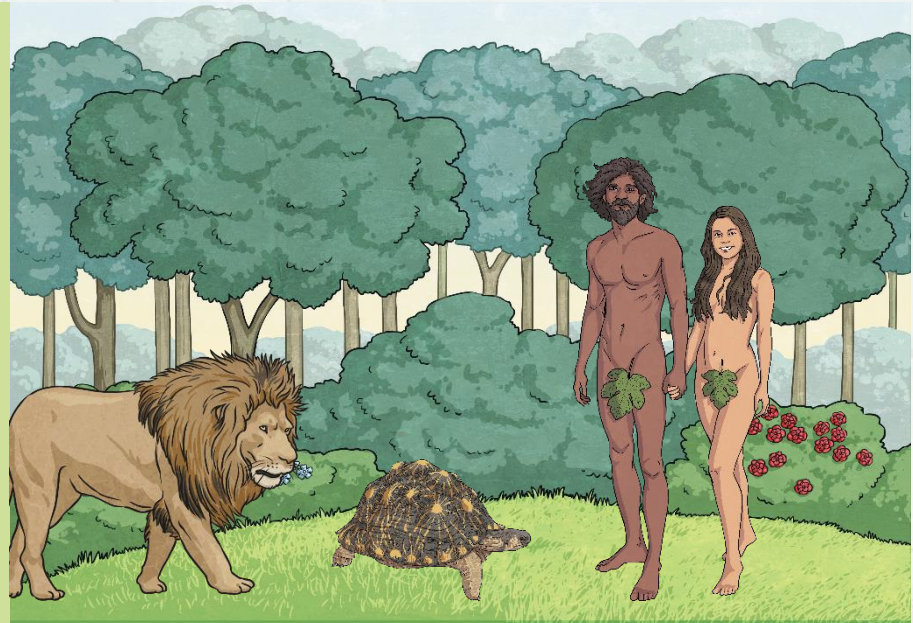
'Fill the water of the seas and let the birds grow in number on the earth'.
