Motif 3 – 0:40 -> 1:19 (stop there)

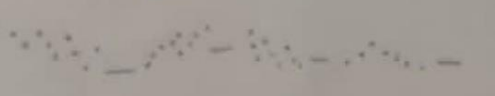
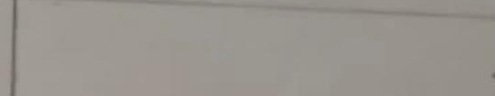
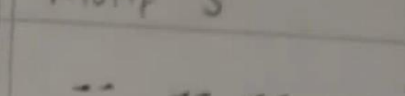
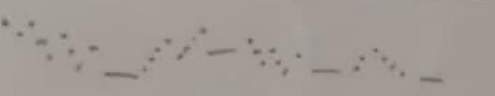
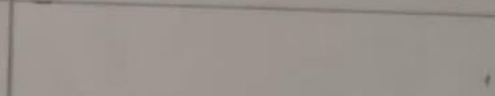
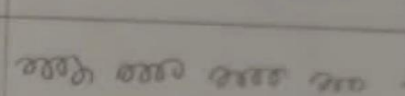
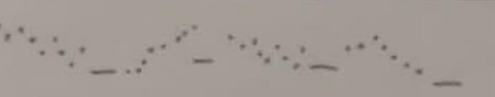
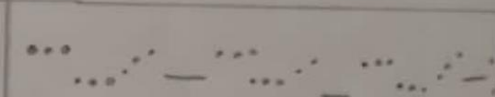
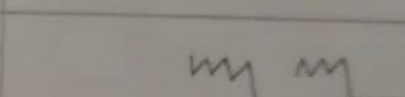
Identify the instruments used throughout the piece of music, and write one in each instrument box.
