Maracas



- 1 Fill a plastic bottle.** Fill an 8-oz (250-ml) plastic bottle halfway with a noise-making material. Tightly secure the cap on the top of the bottle.
 - There are different options you can use for the filling. Pebbles, beans, rice, birdseed, beads, dry pasta, small washers, and paper clips will produce stronger noises. Sand, salt, and small erasers will produce quieter noises.
 - You can also mix different filling materials inside one maraca or use a filling idea not mentioned here. The filling just needs to be small enough to shake around inside the maraca.

Making a Simple Tissue Box Guitar

1. Gather your supplies. This guitar is easy to make, and great for young children. It is your classic tissue box guitar.
2. Find an empty tissue box and pull out the clear plastic piece inside the hole. It should come away easily.
3. Tape the paper towel roll down to one of the skinny ends of the box. You can also attach the roll using hot glue.
4. Decorate the guitar. You can cover the guitar with paper. You can also paint it using tempera or acrylic paints.
