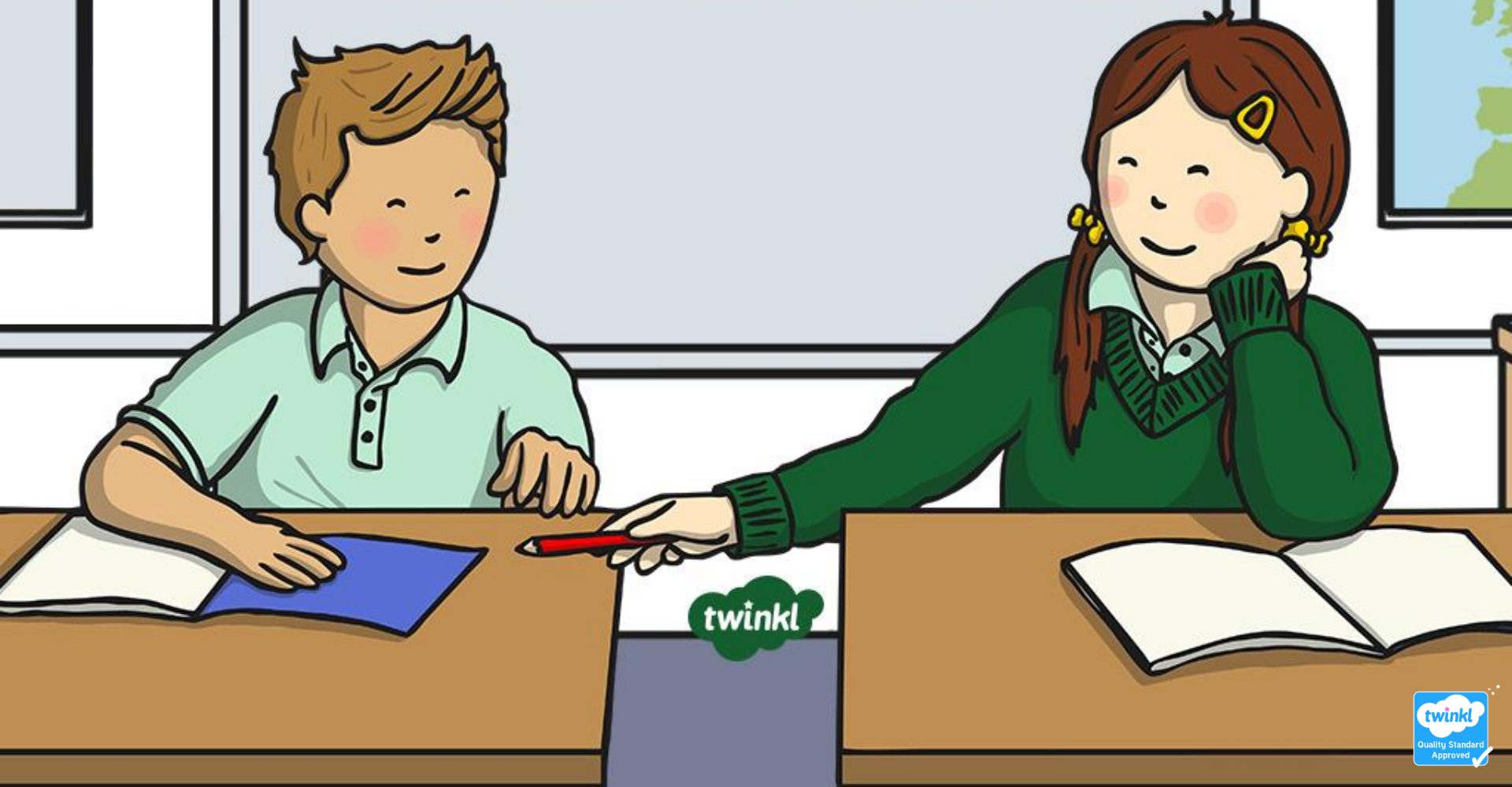


Writing Instructions
