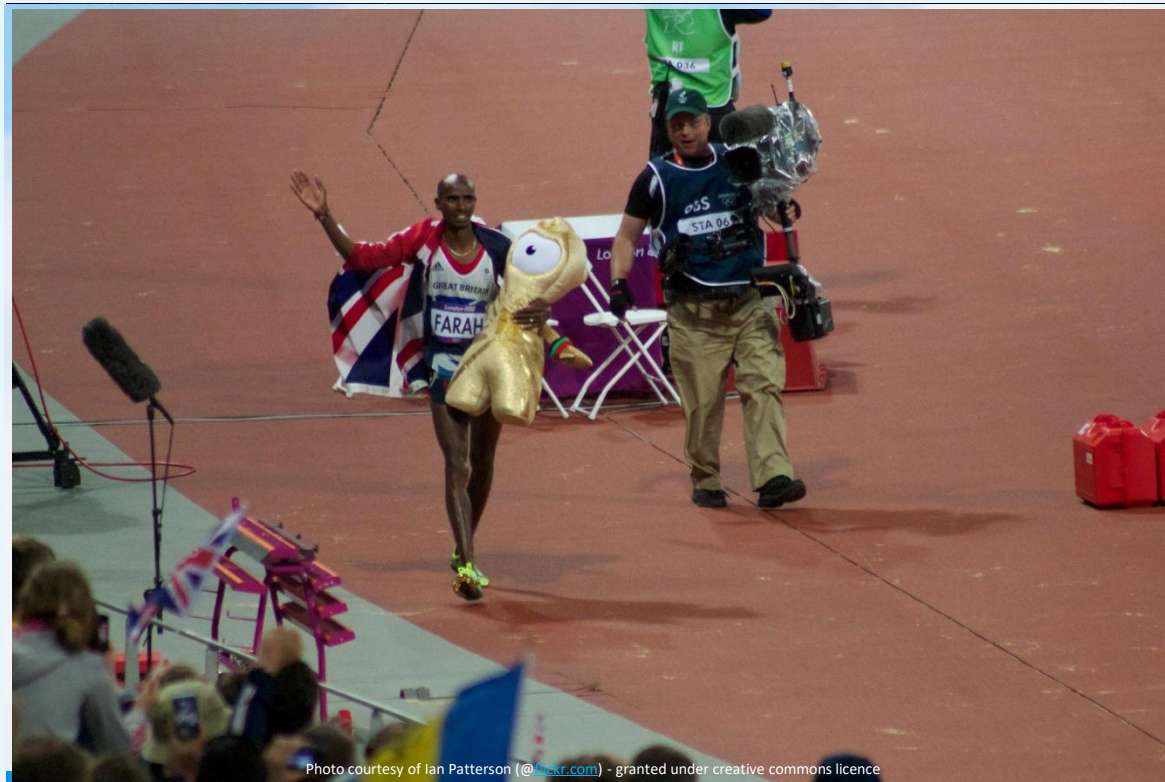

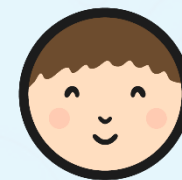

There are lots of reasons why we can feel proud of living in Britain.

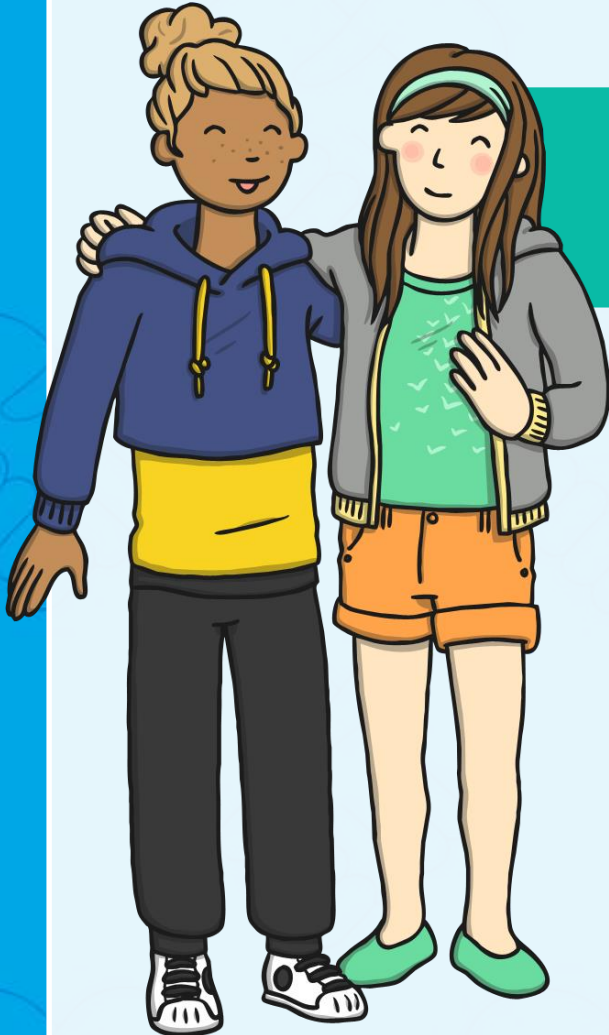
All of us can help our country to stay a place to be proud of.
