Non-Chronological Reports

We write non-chronological reports to give people information on a particular subject.

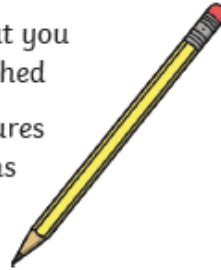
Examples

- non-fiction book
- information leaflet
- fact sheet or fact file



Structure

- use a title
- write an introduction
- put your information into sections
- give each section a sub-heading
- use facts that you have researched
- include pictures with captions



Language Features

- use formal language, e.g. habitat, astronaut, monarch
- remember your full stops and capital letters
- add apostrophes to show possession, e.g. The Queen's birthday.
- use 'that', 'because', 'when' and 'if' to create longer sentences



Wednesday

Have you got your ideas ready from yesterday?

Today we will be writing our title and introduction.

Here we go.....

Title

- What did you write as your title yesterday? I called mine: all about me so I am going to start with the title at the top of the page:

All About Me!

Write your title at the top of your page. You could underline to make it look very important.

Introduction

All About Me!

Challenge 1

Your introduction was scaffolded for you yesterday. Write it neatly into your book underneath the title. Don't forget your capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Challenge 2

Using your ideas from yesterday write your introduction. My introduction is here to help you but make sure you make yours about you! Don't forget to use conjunctions. Challenge yourself to use a conjunction that isn't and!

Thursday

Today we are going to continue our report by writing sub-heading 1 and 2.

Make sure you have your planning out from Tuesday's lesson to help you!
