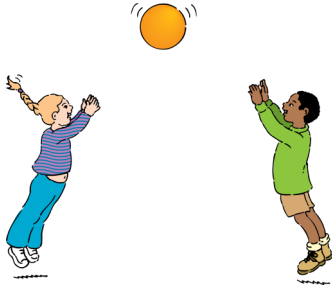


P.E.

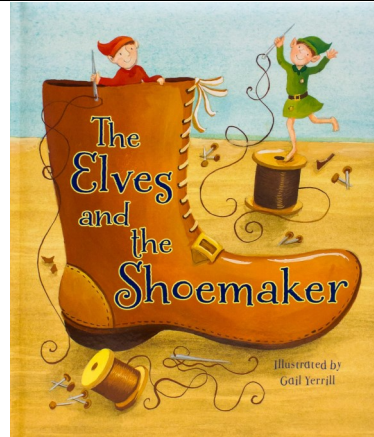

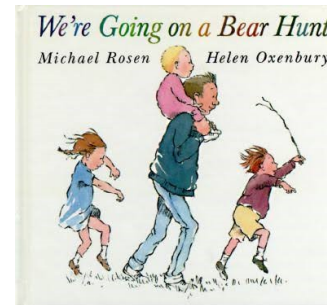
Reading

Explore the astounding world of the scented garden, but be careful, there are some wild and dangerous plants out there that do astonishing things! Don't touch them!

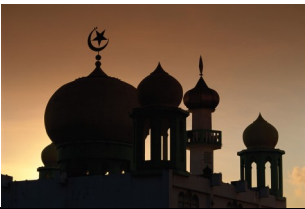
Use the marvellous properties of plants, flowers and herbs to make an exceptional gift for somebody special.

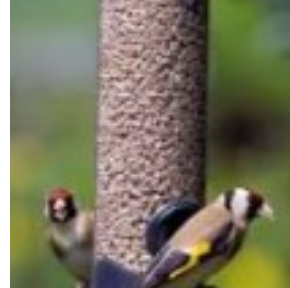

Key Learning: Place Value

- To read, write and order numbers to 100
- To count forwards and backwards in 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s to 100
- To compare numbers talking about the number of tens and ones the number has.

Key Learning: Addition and Subtraction

- To create fact families
- To consolidate strategies to solve addition and subtraction problems
- To quickly recall number bonds to 10 then 20

Key Learning: Multiplication and Division

- To understand multiplication as repeated addition
- To put objects into equal groups
- To share objects fairly making sure each group has the same amount

Key Learning: Fractions

- To find a half or a quarter of a shape or amount
