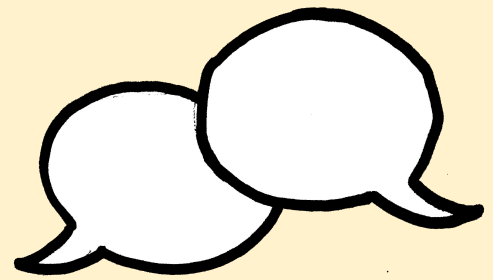
- the great **royal courts** of Egypt

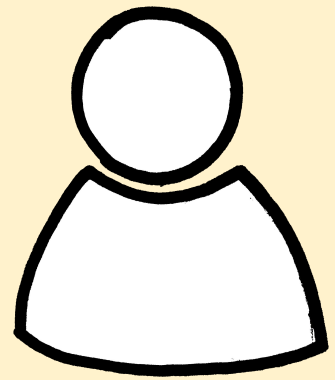
