What does informal mean?

Before we start planning our letters, we need
to think about our PAT

What does PAT stand for?

P – Purpose

A – Audience

T – Type

What will our PAT be for these letters.

So we are now going to work through our planning sheets.

We will talk about each section as we plan it. Thinking about what needs to be included and what we are going to include for our letters.

What is the first part of our letters and our plans?

The recipient's address

Who are we sending these letters to and what address can we use?

Paragraph 1 – The introduction

Paragraph 2

This paragraph informs Apostles class what you are wanting to tell them.

We are going to be telling them about what they will be doing during Traders and Raiders when they are in Year 3!

What comes next?

Paragraph 3 – The conclusion

The conclusion finishes your letter. You remind the reader of the best points and tell the reader that you're looking forward to hearing from them.

The ending and your name
