Expectations for Summer Term

We have all achieved so much whilst in Year 3 already and we cannot wait to see this continue! With this in mind, please find a reminder of some of the expectations within Year 3.

Reading is extremely important and helps children to develop their imagination, writing and spelling. To help this grow, children need to be reading at least five times a week and making an entry into their reading journal every time. Everyone who does read five times a week will be entered into the reading superstar draw for a chance to win a new book and certificate!

Another brilliant way to develop reading and spelling skills is using Nesso. Nesso is an online programme that the children can access from home independently. Everyone, that has given consent, has a Nesso account set up for them. If you have any trouble accessing this please do not hesitate to ask.

Times tables are incredibly important within the vast majority of maths and as a result, it is incredibly important that children are practicing their times tables! A great way to do this is with TTRockstars which everyone still has an account for. If for any reason you are unable to access the TTRockstars account please do not hesitate to tell us so that we can help get it back up and running for you.

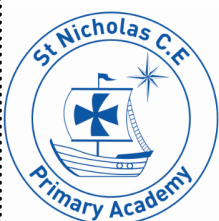
During Science this term our topic is Animals including Humans. During this topic we will be learning about what we need to survive, skeletons, muscles and what makes a healthy balanced diet.
