As part of our 'memorable experience', we are going to make some art inspired by beautiful auroras – a natural phenomenon usually seen in the Arctic and Antarctic skies.

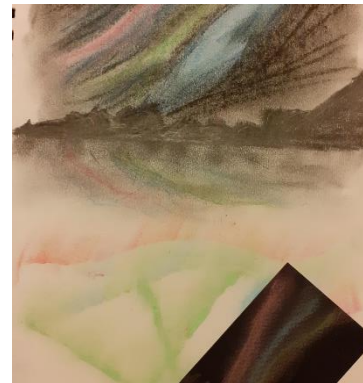
Here are some videos that you might like to watch before you begin. The first explains what auroras are; the second shows their beauty.

This week's art lesson is all about exploring materials before making a final piece of art. Use whatever materials you have at home (wax crayons, chalk, colouring pencils, paint, felt tipped pens etc.), to explore how each can be used to create auroras – what happens if you add water to felt tipped pen marks? Can you find a way to blend crayons or coloured pencils? Why not try watery paint over wax crayon? Here is some of my exploratory work...
