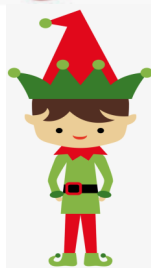

Christmas Crazy!

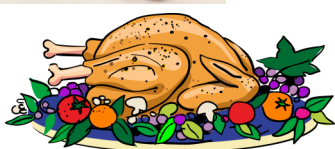
