

P.E.

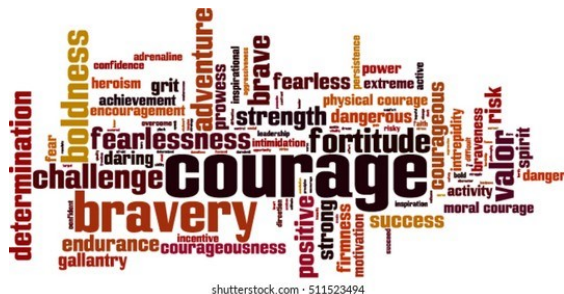
We have 2 sessions of P.E. each week on **Wednesdays** and **Thursdays** so please make sure you **come to school wearing your P.E. uniform** on those days.

Reading

We love to read in Year 1 and look forward to our daily story time. As well as story time, children will also have the opportunity to listen to and read stories during our reading lessons and phonics lessons.

Phonics is taught every day and we encourage children to continue practising using sounds at home when reading and writing.

Our traditional tale of the term is 'The Enormous Turnip'.



Writing

During our writing lessons this term, we will be learning how to write to entertain. This will include writing a 3rd person narrative based on the book 'Wherever next!' and a 1st person narrative imagining we are Neil Armstrong landing on the moon. In our handwriting, we will be focusing on writing capital letters. We will continue working on holding sentences in our head and using our phonics knowledge to support our writing.

'How is Allah described in the Qur'an?'

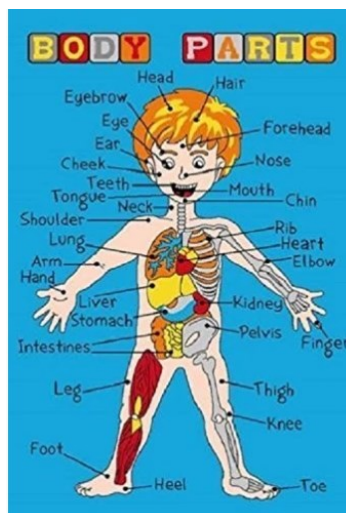


Reminders...

Science

This term we will be learning about the human body and our 5 senses. We will identify and name simple parts of the body and we will explore each sense and how our senses help us find out about the world around us.

Maths

This term our units of work will be: addition and subtraction within 20 and place value within 50. Our key areas of learning this term will be:

- Adding and taking away numbers within 20, counting both forwards and backwards.
- Understanding the 'place value' of numbers within 50.
- Understanding tens and ones and how to represent two digit numbers.
- Comparing numbers and number sentences using $<$, $>$ and $=$ symbols.
- Counting in 2s and 5s.

To help your child with their maths at home, you could play board games, count the stairs, look for numbers when out for a walk or get them to help pay for the shopping with some coins!
