Writing

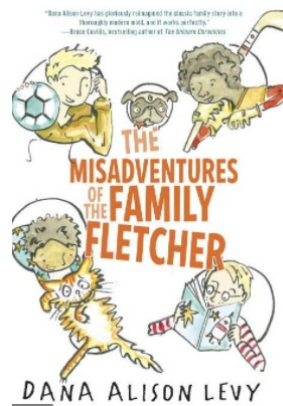
This term we will be writing to persuade. We will study different advertisements, finding out how they persuade people.

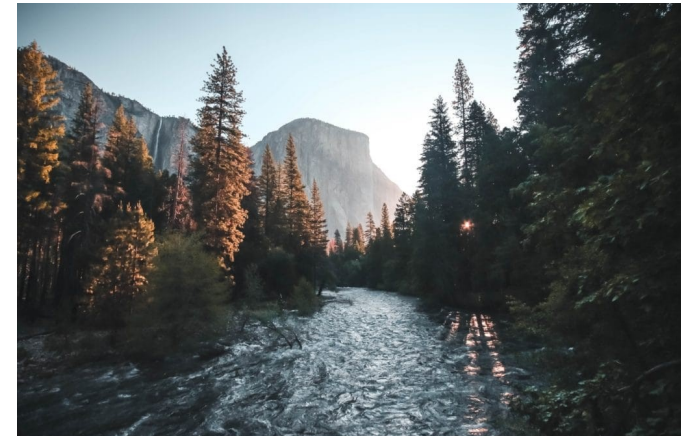
from different backgroundsthere will be many 'misadventures' for us to enjoy!

Science

This term we will be exploring the question: "How do we hear?" We will look at how sounds are made, how they travel and how we use our ears to hear them. The children will work in a hands-on way to explore pitch, and will use their understanding of how high and low sounds are made to create their own set of pan pipes. They will have the opportunity to make a string telephone and will use this to investigate how sounds change over distance and through different materials.



Homework

Nessy and TTrackstars are both set for all children. Children that use these programs each day will receive dojo rewards! Daily reading is also part of our homework and we encourage the children to respond to their reading by recording their comments in their reading diary.

Key Learning: Multiplication and Division

- To multiply and divide by 10 and 100
- To multiply and divide by 1, 3, 6, 7, 11 and 12
- To multiply 3 numbers
- Factors
- To multiply 2 digit by 1 digit
- To divide 2 digits by 1 digit.

Key Learning : Area
