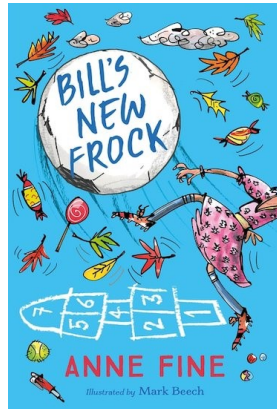
Our Collective Worship theme this term is :

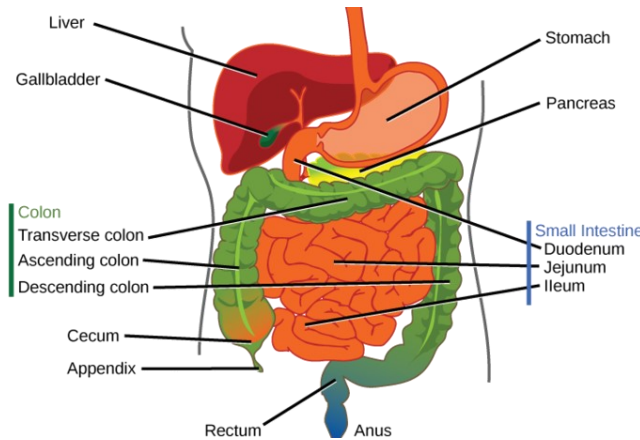

Science

- To exchange when subtracting
